AIRPORT - KOGGALA

25 FEB 17,

MATARA-KANDY

After breakfast, participate the dana programme (Almsgiving) for 100 monks.

Almsgiving is closer to a symbolic connection to the spiritual realm and to show humbleness and respect in the presence of the secular society. The act of alms giving assists in connecting the human to the monk or nun and what he/she represents.

After DANA programme proceed to Kandy (App 05 ½ hrs drive)

KANDY -ANURADHAPURA

Early Morning at **0515hrs** visit **Temple of the Tooth Relic** during Morning Pooja Time Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic. Ever since 4th Century A.D., when the Buddha's Tooth was brought to Sri Lanka hidden from sacrilegious hands in an Orissan princess' hair. The Relic has grown in repute and holiness in Sri Lanka and throughout the Buddhist world. It is considered Sri Lanka's most prized possession.



Breakfast at the Hotel.

After breakfast, adjourn to Kandy city tour including Upper Lake Drive, Market Square, Arts & Crafts Centre, Gem Museum.

Kandy - the hill capital, venue of the annual Perahera. The last stronghold of the Sinhala Kings was finally ceded to the British in 1815. Kandy is an example of the Buddhism's influence in Sri Lanka today. Temples, shrines and monasteries keeping alive Buddhist traditions are everywhere.



Thereafter proceed to Anuradhapura en route Lunch at the Local Restaurant.

Visit Dambutta Cave.

27 FEB 17, ANURADHAPURA - NEGAMBO- AIRPORT

After breakfast leave Anuradhapura for Negambo.

Visit JAYA SRIMAHA BODHI & RUWANWELI MAHA SAYA (App 01 ½ hrs)

Anuradhapura is the most celebrated of Sri Lanka's ancient ruined cities. The city's greatest treasures are its dagabas constructed of small sun-dried bricks and hemispherical in shape. The most notable of these dagabas are the Ruvanweli which dates back to the 2nd Century BC and is 300ft in diameter, the Jetawanarama is 370ft and the Thuparama which enshrines the collarbone of the Buddha. The city's most renewed relic is the sacred Bo Tree which is said to have grown from a branch of the tree under which the Buddha gained enlightenment. It was planted 2250 years ago and is the oldest historic tree in the world.

After dinner transfer to airport in time to connect to the departure flight
